WHY WOULD I WANT TO BE A COUNCILLOR!

To speak on behalf of the local community and help local people, to contribute business or professional skills to public life or to play a role in shaping the future of your local community. Councillors play a vital role in shaping and directing local services for the benefit of the community. They act as the democratic voice of local people and ensure that local services meet local needs.

WHAT'S INVOLVED IN BEING A COUNCILLOR!

The role of a Councillor can be varied and rewarding, including attending monthly meetings always held on the second Monday of every month except August. The time commitment required will depend upon the extent you wish to be involved, at a minimum, approximately two hours a month for the meeting. You may like to become further involved in general parish commitments including visual checks of the play areas or being a member of a working group, the choice is yours.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED!

If you would like to participate in the running and development of the parish, and can spare a few hours each month and fulfil the statutory criteria we would like to hear from you. There is an initial induction programme available to enable you to understand the services and priorities.

It is very important that an active Council has a broad range of people of different ages, with varying interests and experience. You may be new to the parish or have lived in it all your life; all you need is an interest in the parish, its people and its future.

ELIGIBILITY TO BE A COUNCILLOR!

- Be at least 18 years of age
- A British, Commonwealth or European Union Citizen
- Reside within the Parish or within 3 miles of it
- Occupy as an owner or tenant any land or premises or work in the Parish
